JENNINGS WATER RESTRICTIONS EASED TO EXTREME LEVEL

Southern Downs Regional Council advise that as from Thursday, 19 March 2020, water restrictions have eased from Critical Level to Extreme Level of 120 litres per person per day.

Jennings residents are urged to remain vigilant with water usage as, despite recent rainfall, Storm King Dam remains very low, however the situation with supply for Warwick in Leslie Dam has substantially improved. As water for Jennings is provided through Southern Downs Regional Council water storages at Wallangarra, the Extreme Level Water Restrictions applicable to all areas of Southern Downs Regional Council also apply to Jennings.
