

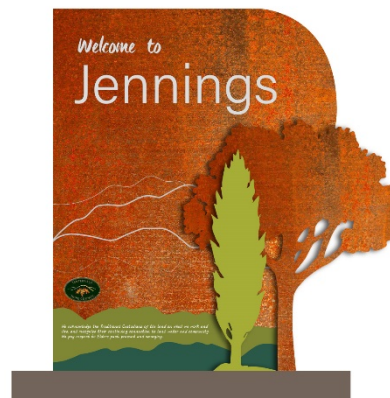

## NEW VILLAGE ENTRY SIGNAGE

New village entry signage will be installed at the entry to each of the following villages; Urbenville, Jennings, Drake, Mingoola, Liston, Legume and Torrington.
