CLOSURE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT – FINES APPLY

COVID-19 Regulations put in place by the Government require that all playgrounds and exercise equipment within the Tenterfield Shire be closed until further notice.

Under no circumstances are persons allowed to enter, or attempt to play on, or use, any equipment. NSW Police will patrol areas and fines apply for breach of the regulation.

Council has placed signage and barrier tape around all equipment for the safety of the public.
