NSW GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCES NEW BUSINESS CONNECT ADVISORS TO HELP HARD-HIT INDUSTRIES

Small businesses in industries hit hard by COVID-19 are set to benefit with 40 new Business Connect advisors being deployed across NSW to help provide valuable advice and guidance.

Among the 40 new advisors are five with a background in tourism – one of the sectors most heavily impacted by the pandemic.

Minister for Jobs, Investment, Tourism and Western Sydney Stuart Ayres said the new advisors, based both in metropolitan and regional areas, would help small businesses navigate the difficult trading conditions.

The advisors are able to connect businesses to the support available from the NSW Government, including Small Business Support Fund Grants and payroll tax waivers and deferrals for eligible businesses.

A number of the new Business Connect advisors have experience running their own businesses in industries dramatically impacted by COVID-19, including the arts and creative industries, retail and tourism.

Once the new advisors start work, Business Connect will have more than 120 business advisors. Advisory sessions with Business Connect are currently free of charge.
