COUNCIL POLICIES ON PUBLIC EXHIBITION

Council resolved at the Ordinary Council Meeting of 25 November 2020 that the following policies be placed on public exhibition and submissions invited.

- Local Orders for the Keeping of Animals in Urban Areas of Tenterfield Shire Policy No 3.120
- Enforcement Policy for Unlawful Activities Policy No 1.051
- Local Orders Policy Policy No 3.123

These three (3) policies are on exhibition for a period of 42 days, being from Monday, 30 November 2020 to 5.00 pm on Sunday, 10 January 2021.

Council also resolved to amend the Fund Raising Stall Policy No 1.060 with regard to relocating the fund raising stalls to 242 Rouse Street instead of the current location at 220 Rouse Street, Tenterfield.
