JENNINGS RESIDENTS NOW OUT OF WATER RESTRICTIONS!

Council's bulk water supplier (Southern Downs Regional Council) for the border town of Jennings has now lifted *Critical Restrictions* to *Permanent Water Savings* measures.

Residents are now able to use up to 200L/person/day. This is great news for Jennings residents who have been on emergency and critical water restrictions for the past 18 months.

During the recent storm and flooding event, the Storm King Dam filled in 36 hours.

UPDATE OF CURRENT FLOOD & STORM DAMAGE TENTERFIELD SHIRE AREA

Council crews have been working hard to clean up flood debris and repair roads and bridge approaches following the recent rain weather event.

Parks & Gardens crews have done an amazing job along Tenterfield Creek, clearing up the footpath and removing debris while trying to stay on top of the rapidly growing grassed areas.

Walkers are warned to be aware of the damage to the Tenterfield Creek footbridge crossing which is currently closed. The bridge components were damaged by major floodwater and debris and will be repaired as soon as resources become available from other critical response works across the road network.

Council's road infrastructure staff have been assessing damage to the network across the Shire and currently the following road closures/restrictions are in place:

- Mole River Road CLOSED to all traffic Bridge over Mole River (Emergency Bridge works being undertaken)
- Pyes Creek Road CLOSED Local traffic only dangerous road conditions, scours & washouts due to heavy rainfall event
- Silent Grove Road CLOSED Local traffic only – dangerous road conditions, scours & washouts due to heavy rainfall event
- **Bruxner Way** CAUTION Bridge over Black Creek – detour side track in place due to bridge damage

"In any event, motorists are encouraged to check the My Road Info website prior to planning their journey. Information is updated as it becomes available", said Mayor Peter Petty.
