Tenterfield Shire Council – Access to Council Facilities

Tenterfield Shire Council is working to ensure the health and safety of the community following NSW Health's announcement of a state wide one-week lockdown.

From 5pm Saturday 14 August 2021, services and facilities will be closed to the public, in line with NSW Health orders.

All Council buildings and sites throughout Tenterfield Shire will be closed to the public, including:-

- Administration Building/Chambers
- Tenterfield School of Arts – Cinema & Museum
- Tenterfield Public Library
- Depot Office (deliveries and scheduled inspections will proceed)
- Visitor Information Centre
- All Waste Transfer Centres
