

PENSIONER CONCESSIONS

A reminder for eligible pensioners to apply for the Pensioner Rebate on their Annual Rates. Application forms can be downloaded from Council's website. Please complete the checklist before submitting your completed application to Council with a copy of the front and back of your Pensioner Concession Card.

You may be eligible for the rebate if ...

- You have a current Pensioner Concession Card, and
- The property is your primary place of residence, and an Occupation Certificate has been issued.

If you already receive the rebate you do not need to do anything unless you have moved since your last Rates Notice, then you will need to re-apply.

RATES & CHARGES FOURTH INSTALMENT NOTICE 2021-2022

Council wishes to advise Residents and Business Owners that the Fourth Rates Instalment Notice is now overdue. Reminder Notices have been issued to rate-payers with outstanding balances seeking payment prior to 5 July 2022.

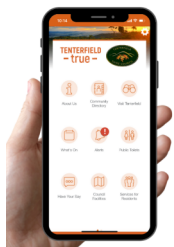
WATER & SEWERAGE NOTICES

Water & Sewerage Notices were issued on 14 June 2022 and payment of accounts are due on or before 1 August 2022. Water & Sewerage Notices are calculated on a 'User Pays' system therefore any consumption that passes through the meter will be charged as outlined in Council's Operational Plan.

Ratepayers are reminded that interest accrues on all overdue rates, service charges and water & sewerage consumption charges on a daily basis at a rate of 6% per annum.

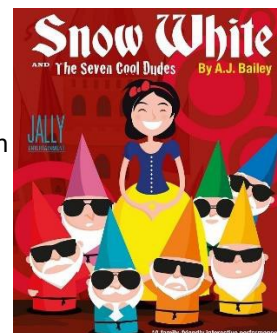

SMOKE TESTING FOR TENTERFIELD SEWER NETWORK

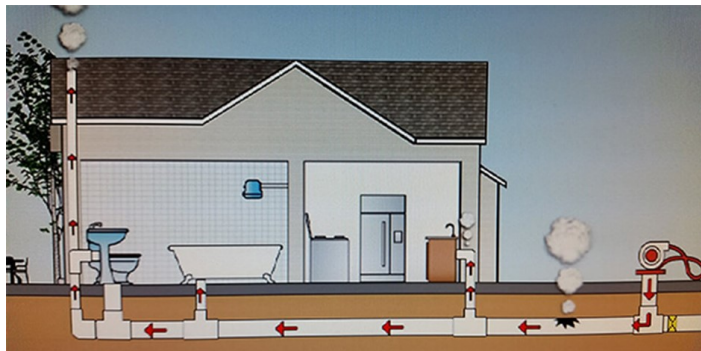
Tenterfield Shire Council has engaged a contractor to undertake smoke testing throughout the Tenterfield sewer network commencing in July.

The aim of this process is to establish where stormwater is infiltrating our sewer system putting increased demand on the Sewerage Treatment Plant during rain events

To check for entry of stormwater into the sewers, contractors will "smoke bomb" the sewer system by forcing smoke up the Council sewer pipes and into house drainage pipes.

The smoke is non-toxic, non-staining and has no odour, is white to grey in colour and does not create a fire hazard. The smoke should not enter your home/business unless you have defective plumbing or dried up drain traps. Smoke coming from broken pipes, grates or downpipes may indicate that stormwater enters the sewer from your property and/or sewer gases may also be entering your home or business.

Any potential issues found during this process will be communicated between council and the house/business owner to establish a plan to rectify any problems found.

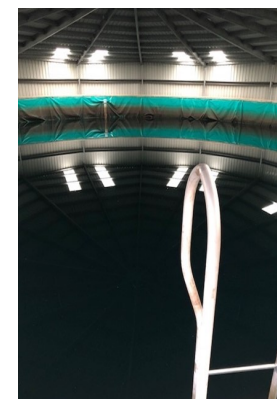

TENTERFIELD'S LEAK DETECTION PROGRAM GETS A BOOST

Council staff have great news for the residents of Tenterfield! Tenterfield has been selected by the Department of Planning and Environment to take part in a pilot program to install bulk water leak detection meters.

The trial program, commenced at the beginning of the year, aims to ascertain the need and requirements of water utilities within the state. Tenterfield was selected to

take part in this pilot program, and Council has been awarded \$36,000 by the Department of Planning and Environment to deliver the project.

Council Staff are now in the planning phase to undertake installation of the new leak detection meters, including a telemetry link for the East Street reservoir (an image of inside the reservoir is left).

Installation of leak detection meters are expected to commence later in 2022.

NEW WATER FILTRATION PLANT CONTINUES ON SCHEDULE

The construction of the New Water Filtration Plant at Scrub Road is on schedule, with site raising works now completed. Components for the plant are progressing with a UV system and two large pumps having arrived on site, and fabrication of process units undertaken by DTB in Tenterfield is continuing.

The new filtration plant will replace our current aging plant and is designed to be water efficient, while providing treatment resulting in greater water quality. The benefits to the community from the new treatment plant's improved processes will allow many savings and environmental benefits.
