Councillors and accompanying Civic staff were most appreciative of Urbenville Progress Association's hosting of the Council Meeting held 23 November at Urbenville Memorial Hall. Following the meeting and community forum, Councillors and Civic staff visited the Urbenville Water Treatment Plant.

Council's Senior Services Officer (Northern) Wayne Orton explained the processes and equipment used at the plant to purify the raw water collected within the catchment area. The installation of new pumps and meters has minimised time spent assessing changes in raw water quality and enabled financial savings due to a reduced need in frequency of backwashing. These additions have profoundly increased the plant's ability to produce excellent finished water for town consumption (adhering to or better than Australian

Drinking Water Guidelines) - no need for bottled water in this beautiful part of the country!







RATES & CHARGES SECOND INSTALMENT NOTICE 2022-2023

Council wishes to advise Residents and Business Owners that payment of the Second Rates Instalment Notice were due on 30 November 2022 and are now overdue.

WATER & SEWERAGE NOTICES

Water & Sewerage Notices will be issued by the end of December 2022 and payment of accounts are due on or before 1 February 2023. Water & Sewerage Notices are calculated on a 'User Pays' system therefore any consumption that passes through the meter will be charged as outlined in Council's Operational Plan.

Ratepayers are reminded that interest accrues on all overdue rates, service charges and water & sewerage consumption charges on a daily basis at a rate of 6% per annum.
