### Gravel & Granite Cycling Event, Tenterfield Saturday 4th March 2023

In accordance with Section 115 of the Roads Act 1993, notice is hereby given that there will be disruptions to all traffic on the following roads on Saturday 4 March 2023 between 7am & 4pm to allow for the Gravel & Granite Cycling Event to take place.

Starting at the Showgrounds in Manners St, the ride will use Pelham St, Douglas St, Western St, Mt MacKenzie Rd, Railway Ave, Kildare Rd, Sunnyside Loop Rd, Bruxner Way, Sunnyside Platform Rd, Schröders Rd, Tarban Loop Rd, Gibraltar Rd, Mole River Rd, Upper Mole River Rd, Woodside Rd and Gunyah Rd.
