WATER & SEWERAGE ACCOUNTS NOW OVERDUE

Water & Sewerage Notices were due for payment on 1 February 2023. Multiple reminder notices have been issued by post and hand delivered notices will be scheduled for delivery on 8 March 2023 to applicable properties.

If full payment of water & sewerage accounts have not been made or a satisfactory arrangement entered into, Council will install a water flow limiter. Limiter installations are scheduled for Wednesday 22 March 2023.

Additional fees will be incurred if a water limiter is installed.

RATES & CHARGES THIRD INSTALMENT DUE FOR PAYMENT

Council wishes to advise Residents and Business Owners that the Third Rates Instalment Notices are now due for payment on or before 28 February 2023. Please note that there was a printing error with the due date "year" that was inadvertently printed as 2022 instead of 2023 on the 3rd instalment notices, Council apologises for any confusion this may have caused.

Ratepayers are reminded that interest accrues on all overdue rates, service charges and water & sewerage consumption charges on a daily basis at a rate of 6% per annum.

NOTICE OF CHANGED CONDITIONS PEDESTRIAN FOOTPATH 275 - 281 Rouse Street, Tenterfield

In accordance with Section 115 of the Roads Act 1993, notice is hereby given by Tenterfield Shire Council as the Roads Authority that the footpath on the eastern side of Rouse Street adjacent to the national building, 275-281 Corner of High & Rouse Street, will have changed conditions on the pedestrian footpath.

For the duration of the project works from 13 February 2023-30 April 2023 - a pedestrian walkway shall be provided at the building worksite. Signage will be erected to direct pedestrians safely around the worksite.

The changed footpath conditions are required to allow for refurbishment of the national building and to prevent conflict between the public and on-site building works.

In accordance with Section 115 of the Roads Act 1993, notice is hereby given that there will be disruptions to all traffic on the following roads on Saturday 4 March 2023 between 7am & 4pm to allow for the Gravel & Granite Cycling Event to take place.

Starting at the Showgrounds in Manners St, the ride will use Pelham St, Douglas St, Western St, Mt MacKenzie Rd, Railway Ave, Kildare Rd, Sunnyside Loop Rd, Bruxner Way, Sunnyside Platform Rd, Schroders Rd, Tarban Loop Rd, Gibraltar Rd, Mole River Rd, Upper Mole River Rd, Woodside Rd and Gunyah Rd.

ROAD CLOSURES:
