These fortnightly sessions will recommence 8 February 2023 and run through to May 2023.

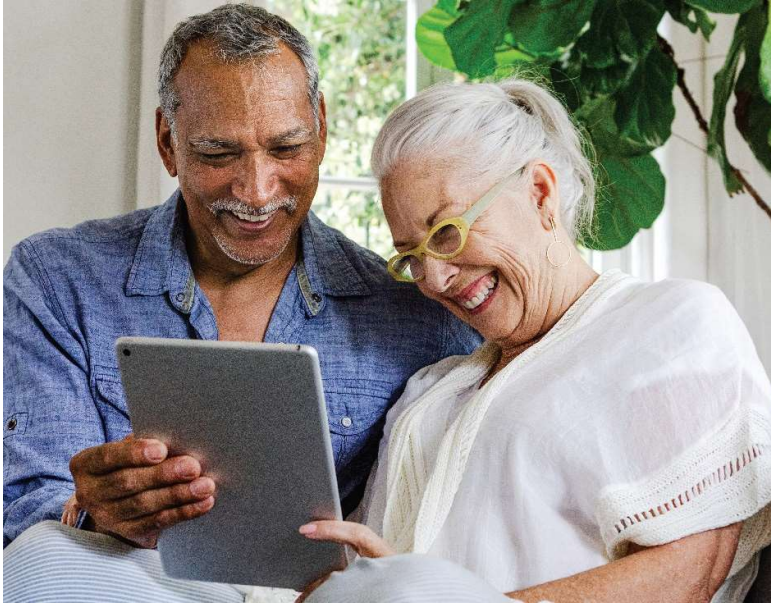

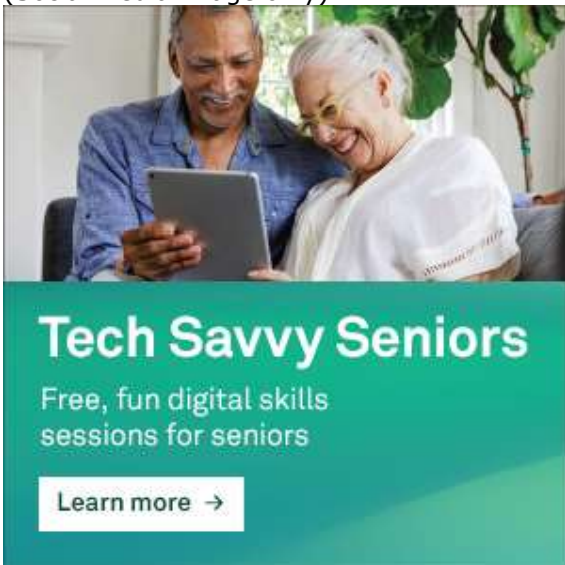
