ANIMAL MICROCHIPPING AND REGISTRATION

Microchipping of a Dog and Cat is required under the Companions Act 1998 Section 70 (1) and it is purely for the identification of the animal. This must occur after the animal reaches 12 weeks or if you buy direct from a breeder. This is Australia wide and there are four organisations which have the details of the owner to that animal.

The idea of microchipping is so that when a Council Ranger picks up the animal they can then obtain the details of the owner through scanning of that animal. It is Council's responsibility to return that animal back to the owner as soon as possible, by getting in contact with the owner of that animal. This simply is for the welfare of the animal. It's also important to make sure your animal's microchip information is up to date if any of your contact details change.

As for registration of the Dog and Cat, it is also a requirement of the Companion Act Section 71, but this is state based in NSW and each Council has a requirement that the owner register their animal with that Council when the animal turns 6 months. This is a seperate process to microchipping. Registering your animal with the Council is a one-off payment which lasts for the life of the animal. There are concessions for those on pensions as well as those who de-sex their animals.

Section 208 (1) Australian Road Rules:

A driver must position the vehicle to face in the direction of travel of vehicles in the marked lane or line of traffic on, or next to, the part of the road where the driver parks.

Section 208A(1)(a) Australian Road Rules:

208A Parallel parking in a road related area (except in a median strip parking area)

(1) A driver who parks in a road related area (except in a median strip parking area) must position the driver's vehicle to face--

(a) in the direction of travel of vehicles in the marked lane or line of traffic next to the part of the road related area where the driver parks, or

(b) if there is no traffic next to that part of the road related area--in the direction in which vehicles could lawfully travel in the road related area, or

(c) if the road related area is an area that divides a road--either--

(i) in the direction of travel of vehicles in the marked lane or line of traffic to the left of the driver, or

(ii) if there is no traffic to the left of the driver--in the direction in which vehicles could lawfully travel on that part of the road

Where on roads that there is guttering on the edges of the road, then the vehicle needs to be parked in the direction of travelling on the road or in the driveway or on the property. The vehicle can not be parked on the nature strip as this is Council land and it is where pedestrians have access to walk.

Water & Sewerage Notices were issued on 14 June 2023 and payment of accounts are due on or before 1 August 2023. Water & Sewerage Notices are calculated on a 'User Pays' system therefore any consumption that passes through the meter will be charged as outlined in Council's Operational Plan.

Ratepayers are reminded that interest accrues on all overdue rates, service charges and water & sewerage consumption charges on a daily basis at a rate of 6% per annum.

Please complete the checklist before submitting your completed application to Council with a copy of the front and back of your Pensioner Concession Card.

You may be eligible for the rebate if ...

- You have a current Pensioner Concession Card, and
- The property is your primary place of residence, and an Occupation Certificate has been issued.

If you already receive the pension rebate on your rates you do not need to do anything unless you have moved since your last Rates Notice or you have had changes to your pension type, then you will need to re-apply.
