SHIRLEY PARK BORE RE-CASING WORK USE OF FOAM

Tenterfield Shire Council's repair, enlargement and deepening of the bore at Shirley Park, is nearing completion. The final stage of the bore upgrade involves cleaning the hole of sediment. A foam material called AMC SUPERFOAMtm is utilised to aid the process of drilling and limit the dusts produced. This phase of the project will be occurring Tuesday the 16th April 2024, foam will be apparent on the Oval.

Shirley Park bore is important as it can supply the Tenterfield town up to one Megalitre of water per day, this is critical in times of drought. As a critical bore Council had the bore inspected and assessed using CCTV in 2022. The Shirley Park bore was constructed in the 90's and required re-casing.

The re-casing will allow Council to continue to operate the bore, along with Councils bore field to provide water to the town when needed.
