VILLAGE BORE COMMENCEMENT AT TORRINGTON

Tenterfield Shire Council received funding from the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery (BLER) Fund grant. This grant is being used to provide livestock with access to water and enhance firefighting capabilities in the villages of Legume, Liston, Torrington and Drake.

The first, second and third bores have been completed at Legume, Liston and Drake, with the Torrington bore to commence drilling within the village of Torrington, located at the crossroads of Sherratt Road and Eschman Lane, near the RFS station. The drilling is expected to commence from the 18 June 2025.

Once completed, the bore water will be available for firefighting and livestock purposes.

Council appreciates the community's patience in waiting for the village bore for Torrington to be completed.

This project is jointly funded by Tenterfield Shire Council and the NSW Government's Bushfire Local Economic Recovery Fund.
